pool memberships has not covered the costs of running and maintaining the pools. Our current and past boards have justified this as something that benefits the entire neighborhood, just as our three parks do. Unfortunately, the time has come to realize that inflation, years of wear and tear, and lack of funds have conspired to make us reconsider the fate of both pools.

The west pool has been closed because it needs major repairs... repairs that may cost us nearly a year's worth of dues. However, we also recognize that the homeowners on the west side of our neighborhood are inconvenienced by not having a pool on their side of Mingo. Even though the pool has been closed, it still incurs expenses, such as periodic draining and cleaning.

Is it worth repairing the west pool? For many years before we closed the west pool, the number of pool memberships has been declining. Our neighborhood is changing, as all neighborhoods do over time.

We want the subcommittee to research not only the issue of repairing the west pool, but also to see if there is a way to make the operation of both pools more self-sufficient...or even if it is better to not operate the pools at all. Controversial? Yes... but we cannot go on without taking some sort of action.

There are other options beyond what this short article can cover... options that may or may not be applicable...but we need your help to find a solution!

Pro or con, please attend the meeting and join the subcommittee. All we ask is that you be willing to discuss this subject in a civilized and reasonable manner.

We will have the pool operating revenue and costs for 2007 and 2008 available at the meeting.
