We have a couple of items we'd like to go over with you this month, starting with...

Maintenance

The Longview Lake Association is responsible for maintenance of the common areas, such as the parks and the pools.

The Longview Lake Association is NOT responsible for the maintenance of homeowner property. This includes your home, fence, yard, trees, sidewalks, and utility easements. We are unable to provide repair assistance for plumbing, electrical, or other needs. It is up to the homeowner to contact a reputable contractor for these repairs.

If you reside in a rental home or duplex, your landlord is responsible for maintenance of the property, not the association. Please help keep <u>your</u> neighborhood clean, safe, and attractive by ensuring that the house <u>and</u> property are kept up by regular mowing and/or repairs as needed.

Parking and Roads

Please move or remove them before the police or Tulsa code enforcement gets involved. We've already had one accident due to a goal in the street—one too many.




Enjoy our Parks!
