Neighborhood Garage Sale -

Park Cleanup -

Volunteers are needed, May 7th! We'd love to have you join us, getting the parks ready for summer fun! Meet in the South Park (at the corner of Mingo and S. 96th East Ave) at 9:00 a.m. Bring your kiddos too! Volunteering gives us an opportunity to change lives, including your own.

Neighborhood Security -

Residents should be alert and watch out for neighbor's homes. Replace burned out lamp post lights, as a critical element of our neighborhood security. Light is the best deterrent for criminals. Knight Watchman does routine rounds of the neighborhood. If you see something suspicious, call 911 and then contact Knight Watchman (918-451-0032) so they are aware of any criminal activity to watch for during their rounds.

Pet Owners Beware -

People are watching! When you walk your dogs, do you pick after them? Do your pets bark all day or night? If you do not take care of your pets, don't be surprised if the City Animal Officer pays you a visit. Pet owners may not consider these things offensive, but most people do. Repeated situations should be reported to the Animal Control at 918-669-6280 (Mon – Fri. 9 - 5 p.m.) It is regrettable that not every pet owner takes their responsibility seriously. Perhaps most unfortunate is that it is not the fault of the pet, but the owner. Please respect your neighbors.

Neighborhood Appearance -

Let's all do our best to make our neighborhood look as clean and appealing as possible. The property value of everyone's home can decrease when we don't keep our yards neatly mowed and edged; leave personal items and trash strewn about; and leave our garbage cans outside for several days before their scheduled pick-up.

Collection of Past Due Accounts -

Another issue that we face is the collection of the annual dues. Each and every resident knew there were Association dues when you purchased your home. It is not fair to the residents who pay their dues in a timely manner to allow others not to contribute to the up-keep of our neighborhood. It is also not the job of any board member to be a collection agency.

The invoices are sent out quarterly. Dues are past due 30 days after the 1st month of the quarter, your account will be sent to the City of Tulsa – Early Settlement Division. This will result in a lien against your property and could affect your credit rating.

Code Enforcement –

I don't think we can stress this enough! Is your neighbor's grass too tall? Cars parked in yards? Disabled vehicles on the street? Motor homes or boats illegally stored? These are the most frequent complaints we receive. You should submit a confidential complaint on the Code Enforcement website: http://www.cityoftulsa.org/reporting/reporting-problems.aspx, or you can call the Mayor's Action Hotline at 918-596-2100. As you can imagine with over 700 homes in the association, the LLHOA cannot police every yard. We really need your help. Our neighborhood is *everyone's* business!

Neighborhood Upgrades:

This past year we've had some major neighborhood expenses which included -

- West Pool demolition the pool was a hazard and in such disrepair it would have been too costly to repair it.
- East Pool Pool drain covers and a drainage backwash system was installed. This eliminated a yearly licensing fee and testing required for chemicals that were previously going into the creek.
- West Office For those of you that have attended meetings in the last few years know how badly the
 roof was leaking. A new roof was installed in October, along with removing the problematic windows
 in the office area.

Did You Know?

The City of Tulsa has a new, more homeowner friendly mulch available from the Green Waste site? The site is located ½ mile west of Highway 169 on 56th St. North. It is open 7 days a week from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Potholes should be reported to the Mayor's Action Line at 918-596-2100.

The City or Tulsa offers bulky waste pickup right from your curbside. This includes furniture and large appliances. Not included are green waste items and construction debris. For more information call 918-596-9777.

To report a non-functional street light call AEP-PSO's customer service number: 888-216-3523 and state you are reporting a streetlight outage at a specific address. If it is a minor repair such as a bulb or photo cell they will attempt to repair it within three business days. A more complicated problem will take longer to repair.
