From our Security Service...

Here are some homeowner tips from our security service, JR Investigations, to help keep you safer:

Add more lighting to your home's perimeter. Go around your house at night to see where the "dark spots" are at. There are lights that can be purchased that only come on when motion is detected or low level lighting that remain on during dark hours. Remember that we are approaching the end of daylight savings time.

Next tip, always make sure vehicles are locked. I have had several calls on car break-ins where the owner didn't lock the vehicle. Also, you may think about a vehicle alarm system especially if your vehicle is always parked outside, this will give a loud audible sound for you or your neighbors to hear and

- A parent or responsible adult should always accompany young children on their rounds.
- By using a flashlight, children can see and be seen by others.
- Only trick-or-treat at homes that have a porch light on.
- Never enter a stranger's home or car for a treat.
- No treats are to be eaten until they are thoroughly checked by an adult at home.
