From the Board...

It's going to be busy in our neighborhood for the next few months!

First of all, two important area representatives will be attending our board meetings:

- **Karen Gilbert**, our District 5 City Commissioner, will be attending our next meeting (July 13th) at the LLA office (West Park, 2702 South 96th East Ave.). Please come with your questions and concerns. This is your chance to be heard!
- **Ken Yazel**, our Tulsa County Assessor, will be at the following meeting (August 10th, also at the LLA office). He will talk about our property values and more. Again, this is your chance to be heard!

The second item is that we are looking for new board members. If you are interested in the betterment of our neighborhood, **please** consider joining. The commitment is just one meeting a month, which usually lasts under an hour.

The next item is the city project for renovation of the streets on the west side of Mingo between 21st and 31st streets. The work begins on South 90th East Ave. (which is the street at Skelly School) on June 22nd. They will replace the traffic signal at that intersection and have that area completed prior to the first day of school.

Work will start on the south end of Longview Lake Estates and work north toward East 21st. They will work on a couple streets at a time, replacing sidewalks, and move minimal utilities then come back with new asphalt on the streets. There will be a couple of days during the project where residents will not have access to their driveways. It would also be

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wise not to leave vehicles parked on the street during this time.

Please be patient during this process as it will be a much needed improvement to our sidewalks, streets and neighborhood.

Finally, we look forward to the reopening of the former Mayo Demonstration School, which will become the Tulsa Honor Academy. It will be opening in the fall when the Tulsa Public Schools are back in session.

This means that there will once again be a school zone with flashing lights on 101st. Please use caution when driving through this zone.

Yard and Bulky Waste Pick-up

All trash outside of your cart, except for yard waste, must be bagged and tied with an orange "Extra Refuse" sticker applied to each bag.

- Yard waste:
 - Will be collected only on the primary service day (Tuesday).
 - Must be in clear plastic bags or in tied in bundles no more than 2 feet around and 4 feet long.
 - Is limited to 15 bundles or bags per week.
 - Bundles and bags must not exceed 40 pounds.
- Bulky items, such as appliances, mattresses, or anything too large to fit inside of the refuse cart will only be picked up by the large trash pick-up service. There is a \$5 fee per collection, with a pre-set volume limit of approximately eight cubic yards (about the size of a small car such as a Volkswagen Beetle).

To schedule a bulky waste collection, please call (918) 596-9777 two business days prior to your primary service day. The collection of bulky waste items will occur only on that day.

Electronic waste should be properly recycled. The MET (Metropolitan Environmental Trust) location on Sheridan accepts most e-waste items (but not televisions). Don't forget about items that contain rechargeable batteries, such as cordless phones, laptop computers, and solar yard lights.

Summer Fun!

It's not too late to join the Longview Lake pool! Swimming is fun and is a low-impact form of exercise.

An application was printed in the April-June newsletter or can be downloaded from the web site shown on the first page.

For those of us that don't swim frequently, daily pool passes are available for \$5.00 per day per person.

Pool passes are also available at a discount when purchased in bulk: 10 passes are only \$40.00 or 20 passes are a bargain at \$70.00.

Come out and see our wonderful and well-maintained pool! Lifeguards are always on duty and refreshments are available.

Got Mosquitoes?



It's not just you. Recent rains have brought the mosquitoes out en masse. The latest weather predictions are for a wet summer...perfect for breeding. Please check your yards for places that mosquitoes breed, like forgotten dog bowls, un-

covered trash cans, buckets, and areas with poor drainage.

A mosquito carrying the West Nile virus was found just to the west of our area in May.

If you have mosquitoes, please call the City of Tulsa Mosquito hot line at **595-4219** anytime (now would be a good time) to leave a message if you would like the City to spray our neighborhood. You will be asked to provide your name and address.

This service is driven solely by the volume of calls, so be sure to call if you are being "bugged."

No Fireworks!

Fireworks are <u>illegal</u> in the City of Tulsa. If you want to enjoy fireworks...and save money... take in one of the many free area fireworks displays. They're far better than what you can do at home!



Vehicle Restrictions

The association receives many complaints about parked vehicles. Please remember that you should not park in a way that blocks sidewalks, driveways, or emergency access. Vehicles must not be parked on the grass.

Also, any vehicles parked in the street or in your driveway must be drivable.

Please Pay Your Dues on Time!

Homeowners that fail to pay their dues will be taken to small claims court.

Our dues have not increased in years, leaving us (in effect) with less and less to work with each year. Every dollar collected is used to maintain and improve our neighborhood.

Stay Safe!

Make sure to maintain and turn on your porch and security lights. More light means less crime in the neighborhood. Overgrown shrubbery also needs to be trimmed to not be hiding spaces for burglars.

Summertime also means more people out and about. Although we have a neighborhood security patrol, we still need your help watching out for suspicious persons and activities.

If you are going on vacation, be sure to stop paper and mail delivery and ask a trusted neighbor to keep an eye out on your property.

The Rains Came (and Went)

Please remember that City of Tulsa ordinances (as well as considerateness for your neighbors) dictates that you keep your grass maintained regularly.

Trash, tree limbs, and other debris should be dealt with as soon as possible.
