PROTECT YOUR CARS AND PROPERTY

We CONTINUE to receive reports of car and household theft and/or break-ins.

In almost all of the cases the car was unlocked, or someone's billfold/purse/cell phone/laptop/cash/jewelry was in plain sight through a window.

Thieves WILL look in your car windows. They WILL break windows or jimmy locks to get to something they think is valuable. It takes just a few seconds to do a smash-and-grab.

If you keep the garage door opener in the car (and we all do), the thief will then have access to your house!

Please lock your cars, don't keep valuables in the car, and keep your garage doors shut. And please make sure to light up your driveway and front porch!

From the Board...

The Tulsa Fire Department asks residents to make their house numbers visible on the house and curb.

Also, keep in mind that when parking on both sides of the street, please leave enough room for a large fire truck to pass through. Parking close to the curb as possible will allow enough room. This will help to speed up their response time.

Please Pay Your Dues on Time!

Homeowners that fail to pay their dues will be taken to small claims court.

As of January 1, 2016 we now charge a \$1.00 per month service fee for delinquent accounts.

Our dues have not increased in years, leaving us (in effect) with less and less to work with each year. Every dollar collected is used to maintain and improve our neighborhood.

Storm Drains

We'd like to remind everyone that the storm drains MUST be kept clear of debris such as leaves, plastic trash, and the like. With all of the leaves on the ground at this time, it may be tempting to just rake them into the drains... please don't!

Also, storm drains are for storm runoff only. No oil, grease, or other liquids are to be placed in the drains.

Trash Talk

We continue to have homeowners and renters that insist on putting the trash out much too early...please don't put it out more than one day in advance, and please be sure to retrieve your cans from the curb the day the trash has been picked up.

Something to Consider

Some insurance companies provide auto coverage discounts if your vehicles are garaged.

Restrictions

Please help us keep our neighborhood looking like a respectable place to live. We have by-laws for the neighborhood that everyone must follow. If you don't, the City of Tulsa can potentially fine you if you do not comply with the request. There are some restrictions that you may receive a letter from the Homeowners Association asking you to take care of a violation.

If you see something that needs to be reported, please email us at longviewlake@gmail.com and attach a picture of the violation (if possible take a picture that includes the tag number). We will be happy to report it for you. Keep in mind, when we report any violation to the City of Tulsa, the violations are added to the inspector's schedule and due date is set. That due date could be up to 45 days later.

Some of the restrictions are as follows:

- Many complaints about parked vehicles.
 - You should not park in a way that blocks sidewalks, driveways, or emergency access.
 - Vehicles must not be parked on the grass. This includes boats and trailers.
 - Any vehicles parked in the street or in your driveway must be drivable.
 - You should not park vehicles such as semicabs and trailers, dump trucks, delivery vans and catering/food trucks in our neighborhood. These oversized vehicles block the sidewalks or make it difficult for other vehicles to pass on the street.

This is especially dangerous for fire trucks and ambulances that may need to get through in a hurry.

The Longview Lake Association, Inc. is composed of all homeowners in the Longview Lake Estates. The Association is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors which are elected at large by all members on the second Thursday of November each year. The Covenants, Bylaws, Articles of Incorporation, Minutes of all meetings and Financial Statements are available to all members upon request. All Board meetings are open to members of the Association.
